Rules of application for bursary

All applications must be sent to the organisation with whom you are booking the course.

All bursary applications must be supported by some evidence to show your organisation has up to £20k income a year – this could be copy accounts, copy bank statements or a supporting letter from a development worker who knows your group if you do not yet have financial statements.

If you are applying for a bursary we require a £10 booking deposit to be sent with the form. This will be used to secure your place and you will have this returned to you in full on confirmed attendance at the course.

Should you not be able to attend for any reason (i.e. illness, or other circumstances) please let us know as soon as you are able. Non communication or non attendance will result in the returnable deposit being kept. Only in unavoidable circumstances will we return your deposit for non attendance and this is to be at the discretion of the organisation hosting the training
